Executive Summary

In order to meet the ethics requirements that the project must comply with, this deliverable deals with protection of personal data as well as the legal and ethical issues which are relevant to the project. This is put into practice by knowing, observing, understanding and implementing solutions by all COREALIS partners. For this purpose, the Grant Agreement and especially the Description of Action relative to Work Package 10 have to be considered.

Here, it is relevant for all beneficiaries to act in compliance with ethical principles and with national legislations regarding the protection of personal data.
