Port of Valencia:

- Second Port in the Mediterranean (Container Cargo)
 with a 5.4M TEU annual throughput & 81M Tons (2019)
- More than 1M passengers traffic (regular lines and cruises)
- More than 5,000 Trucks calling daily at the Port Gates (One single Port Access) & Rail share 7.3%
- Port Hub: 50% I/E and 50% transhipment
- Privileged location:
 - WEST MED: Suez-Gibraltar axis
 - geostrategic position on the Iberian Peninsula

Port Strategies:

Port 4.0 / Zero emissions / Innovation























The Port | Connectivity





Road Access

- Southern Automatic gates
- 5,000 trucks per day
- One single road access

Railway Access


- Inland rail terminal
- 35 trains/week
- Trains up to 750m
- 171.250 TEUs/year
- FFCC: 7.3% of Modal Split







COREALIS Truck Appointment System



Functionalities of the TAS:

- Dynamic Capacity Management by Container Terminals
 - Queues (Empty, full, import, export, etc.)
 - Slots
- Appointment Management with dynamic rescheduling with real time information
- Real-time monitoring & information of operations (performance, waiting times, etc.)
- ETA Estimated Time of Arrival in real time
 - > Terminal operators
 - Transport operators
 - Drivers









Just In Time Rail Shuttle Service

Objective: Elaborate a feasibility Study of an innovative JIT rail shuttle for key port-hinterland corridors (Specific study for one corridor) to **increase the modal split** of the railway for inland transport

Outputs and KPI's

- Solution Design & Service Characteristics
- Process reengineering & IT functional requirements
- Business Models and Market Analysis

Service KPI's

(e.g. Number of Daily Trains, Total TEUs/Tons transported, etc.)

Operational KPI's

(e.g. Modal split, Dwell Time in the terminal, etc.)
