#### **Circular Economy In Ports**

Port-City collaboration scheme for circular waste management: Use of urban and port waste to have a km 0 valorisation that returns to the city and the port.

What we are looking for: Energy models based on waste, use of technological platforms for sharing information on waste, waste traceability, etc...



#### **Optimization of Road Transport Operations**

Synchronization and optimization of road transport operations through greater use of available assets, visibility of operations and a reduction of inefficiencies.

What we are looking for: Solutions proposed must provide greater transparency and visibility that result in an optimized planning of port operations.

Port and foreign trade experts will support and advise participants.




### Jury


### What will happen after the Hackathon?


